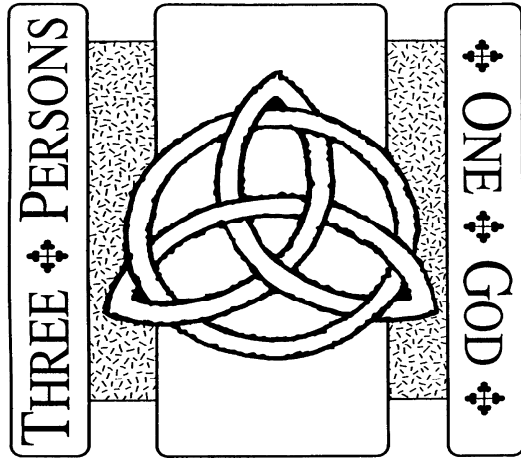

## THE TRINITY IS LOVE

Theologians throughout the Christian centuries have spilled much ink (and, on occasion, some blood) in describing and defining the mystery of the Holy Trinity. One of the earliest, most poetic, and beautiful descriptions comes from St. Augustine in *De Trinitas*, wherein he describes the Trinity as One (the Father) who loves, One (the Son) who is loved, and One (the Spirit) who is love. And these three Ones are also one Three.

It might be wisest for us to leave the technical wranglings to the academic theologians, and focus on the fact that the three Persons of the Trinity are indeed persons; they are best known and understood in their love for each other and for us. We are made in the image of those loving persons, and our best relationships are lived out in the context of love. Truly loving relationships are inexhaustible mysteries to be lived in joy. If this is true of our human relationships, how much more so is it true of our relationship with the Trinity. And how much more does it call upon us to be joyful, loving witnesses of the holy mystery of the One-in-Three. This is the mystery to which we were called when we were chosen to be God's own, baptized with water in the name of the Holy Trinity.

Today is a day simply to ponder the fact that in baptism we were claimed by God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The first reading from Deuteronomy prompts us to fix in our hearts the truth that God is the Lord of both heaven and earth and there is no other god. Saint Paul reminds us that, because we received the Spirit of adoption in baptism, we are now children of God. In the Gospel Jesus charges us with the responsibility to make other disciples. These realities make today's solemnity a day of praise, adoration, and responsibility. It is a fitting day to thank God for the absolutely free gift of faith that we were given in baptism. It is also a day to ask God for strength to take on the responsibility of sharing that faith with others.

## Corpus Christi Celebration

Next Sunday, June 14th is The Feast of Corpus Christi. We will celebrate this Solemnity in a special way here at St. Pius X Church on Sunday, June 10th at the 10:00 am Mass. At the conclusion of Mass, a procession with the First Communion Class will lead us around the church and then outside where songs, prayers and Benediction will highlight the celebration. Refreshments will be served after the procession and Benediction. Please join us in this special celebration for the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus. There will also be a "Welcoming" for our New Parishioners following the procession.

## THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK – JUNE 28 - 12:00 PM MASS

*"Is any one among you sick? Let him call for the presbyters of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins he will be forgiven."*



**On Sunday June 28 , 2009 during the noon liturgy, you will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of The Anointing of the Sick.** It is available to us to strengthen and heal us, and to give us the peace and courage to endure the sufferings of illness and old age in a Christian manner. The rite reflects Jesus' concern for the sick and invokes special graces on those whose physical health, age, or circumstance move them to cry out to Jesus for healing. Through this communal celebration we join together to pray with and for the aged, the ill, those with an upcoming surgery or those with emotional distress.

**Anyone who is chronically ill, elderly, frail, or emotionally distressed is invited to receive this sacrament and participate in this celebration.** It will strengthen you in the difficulties of your illness or age and fortify you in the struggles of your life. Through it the Holy Spirit it will lead you to healing within your soul and your body if that is God's will.

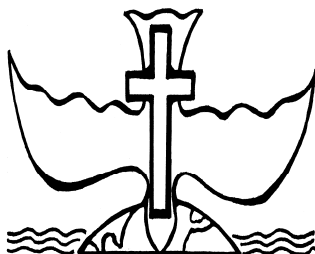

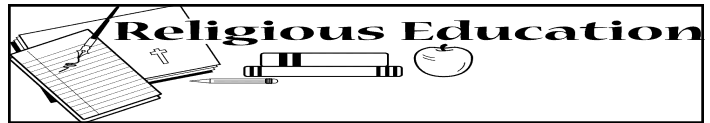

+ In the first reading from Deuteronomy, Moses proclaims the unique relationship God invites His people into, as a Jewish nation. He urges them to fix their heart solely on their awesome God. *On what and on whom do you focus your attention? Do you fix your heart on God?*

Paul's letter to the Romans reveals his understanding of this relationship through faith. He sees each person whether Gentile or Jew as part of the family of God. All are connected through the Spirit of God. *Do you see God as your Father? Do you look on other Christians as part of your family? Do you work on these relationships as you might work on any family relationship? Care for them as you would any family member? Commit your life to serve them as you would Jesus Himself?*

Matthew's gospel proclaims Jesus' "Great Commission" to all disciples. It is no small matter or request. Jesus demands one thing of us as faithful disciples ... to spread the Good News! It is our obligation as members of His Family. However, He promises we'll never be alone. *Do you trust the Lord to guide you in witnessing the gospel? Do you rely on Him to give you the right words? Do you ask the Spirit to show you the right timing? Are you willing to do it His way rather than your way?*

This week, as we celebrate Trinity Sunday and direct our hearts toward the Most Holy Trinity. Let us live up to our family obligations and share the fullness of God's love with those about us. Then we will see Jesus' Great Commission fulfilled.

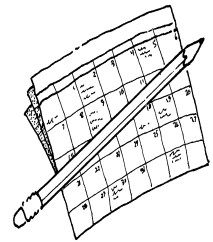

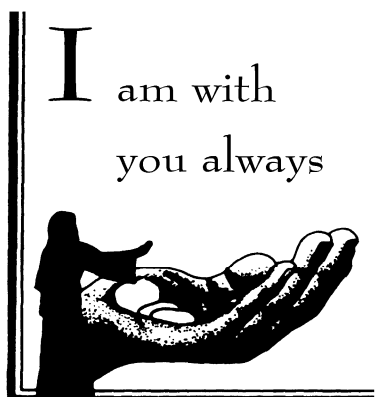

A Tradition of Faith

The historic St. Agnes Cemetery in Menands was incorporated in 1867 during the Rural Cemetery Movement of the mid-19<sup>th</sup> Century. One of the Albany Diocesan Cemeteries, St. Agnes Cemetery continues to serve the Albany Catholic community as a sacred place of burial. Today, the cemetery is comprised of 114 acres and contains over 85,000 burials.

To commemorate Memorial Day and Flag Day, and to honor the many veterans who served our country in time of need, St. Agnes Cemetery, in conjunction with the Albany Aqua Ducks, is sponsoring a Trolley Tour of the military graves of beautiful St. Agnes Cemetery, on Saturday, June 13, 2009, from 10:00 to 12 noon.

Local historian Mark Bodnar will guide you on a special "Military Tour of St. Agnes Cemetery". Weaving a tapestry of military interest, genealogical research and local history, you'll visit the graves of some prominent, and some not-so-prominent, people from the Albany area that served in various wars. Soldiers of the Nicaraguan Campaign, the Civil War, the Spanish American War, World Wars I and II, the Korean War, The Vietnam War, and the Iraq War are all represented on the tour. You will also be introduced to two Medal of Honor recipients on the tour route.

The tour will start at the Cemetery Office at 10:00 AM. The Trolley will take us to several stops in various sections of the cemetery. The graves we will visit reflect the history of people from the Albany area that served in the military, all of whom have unique and interesting stories to be told. Estimated touring time is 2 hours.
